### **Narration, Recitation, and Picture Studies**

Heritage's view of the way children learn is influenced by the ideas of Charlotte Mason. Mason, an educator from mid-nineteenth-century England, pioneered teaching methods that took advantage of a child's natural curiosity and delight in discovery. Her ideas engaged a child's heart and imagination in the learning process. Our emphasis on narration, recitation, and picture studies (in addition to our emphasis on habit training, nature studies, and living ideas) reflects the Charlotte Mason influence at Heritage. We hope to nurture young people who have a genuine love of learning, and this workshop which is geared towards EI-C2 parents will be led by three veteran Heritage teachers, **LeAnn Martin**, **Celia McCarthy**, and **Hannah Wight**, who all do a beautiful job instilling that joy. Come and be equipped with these time-tested teaching methods and you, too, will find delight in supporting your children in these early years of learning!
